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# Temporary and Disability Assistance Statistics APRIL 2008

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## Temporary Assistance

Temporary Assistance: Temporary Assistance recipients totaled 514,691 in April 2008, increasing by 1,303 (+0.3%) from the previous month. Related expenditures totaled \$195,263,117 in April 2008 increasing by approximately \$34.2 million (+21.3%) over March 2008.

## Food Stamps

Food Stamps: Recipients of Food Stamps numbered 1,968,193 in April 2008, increasing by 17,611 (+0.9%) over March 2008. Food Stamps expenditures totaled \$215,621,704 in April 2008, increasing by approximately \$2.1 million (+1.0%) over the previous month.

## Supplemental Security Income

Supplemental Security Income: For April 2008, SSI recipients (including Mental Hygiene) totaled 651,078 decreasing 3,393 (-0.5%) from the previous month. SSI expenditures in April totaled \$352,673,305 increasing by approximately \$2.3 million (+0.6%) from March 2008.

**Note: Food Stamp data in this report has been revised since its original publication to reflect retroactive adjustments to New York City, and thus statewide, figures that resulted from reporting changes (see Table 16 for details). New York City monthly average aggregate claims data on Table 23 has also been changed from the original.**

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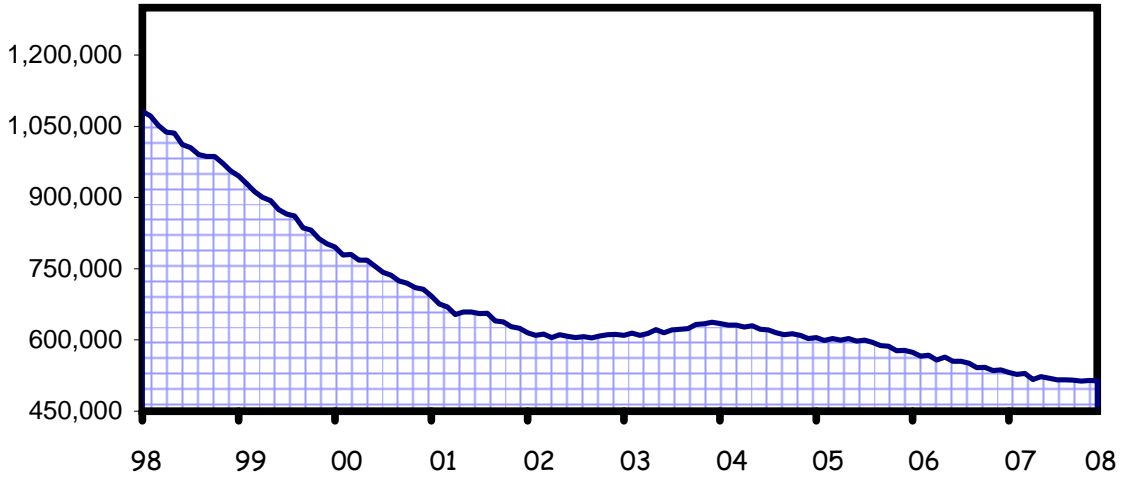
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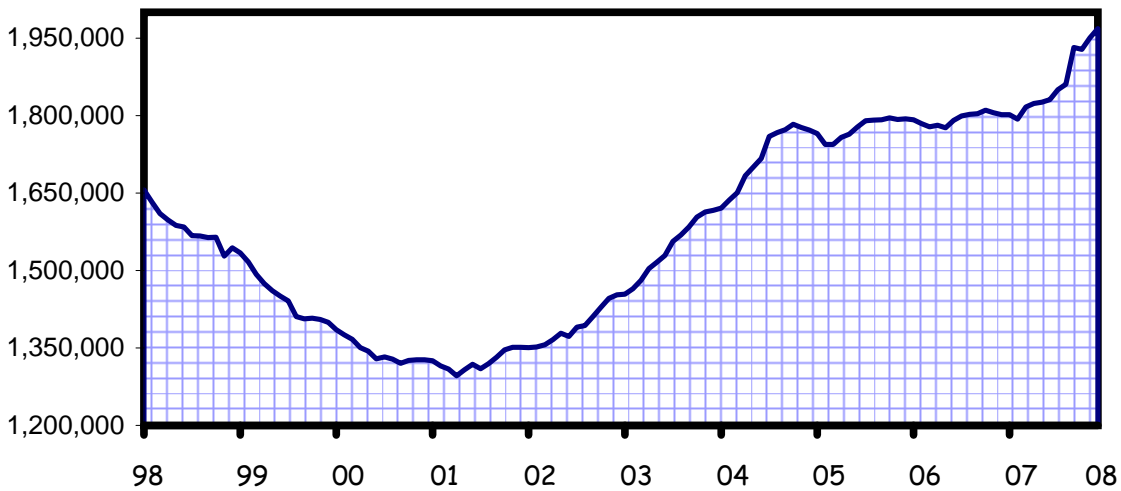
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# NEW YORK STATE MAY 1998 - APRIL 2008 TEN YEAR TREND

## TEMPORARY ASSISTANCE RECIPIENTS

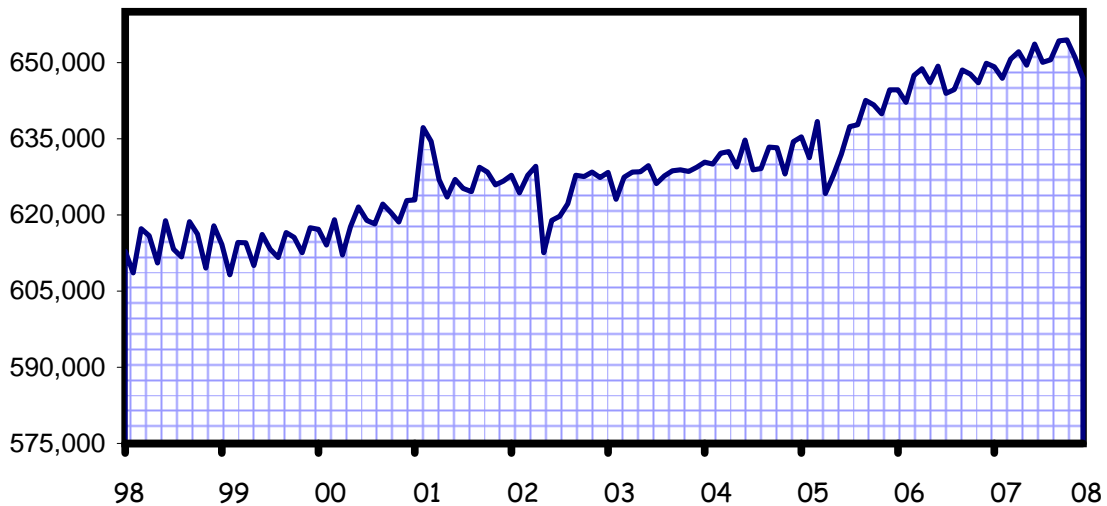


## FOOD STAMPS RECIPIENTS
