Temporary and Disability Assistance Statistics

July 2008

Temporary Assistance

Temporary Assistance: Temporary Assistance recipients totaled 506,167 in July 2008, decreasing by 2,210 (-0.4%) from the previous month. Related expenditures totaled \$168,089,911 in July 2008, increasing by approximately \$16.6 million (+10.9%) over June 2008.

Food Stamps

Food Stamps: Recipients of Food Stamps numbered 2,030,668 in July 2008, increasing by 26,157 (+1.3%) over June 2008. Food Stamps expenditures totaled \$221,639,225 in July 2008, decreasing by approximately \$1.0 million (-0.5%) over the previous month.

Supplemental Security Income

Supplemental Security Income: For July 2008, SSI recipients (including Mental Hygiene) totaled 653,266, decreasing by 4,082 (-0.6%) from the previous month. SSI expenditures in July 2008, totaled \$345,332,579, decreasing by approximately \$9.4 million (-2.7%) from June 2008.

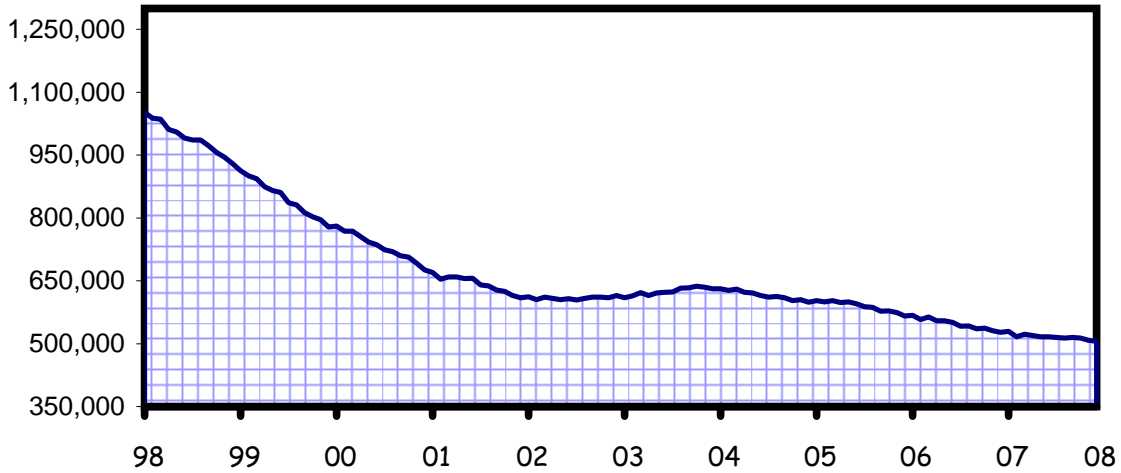

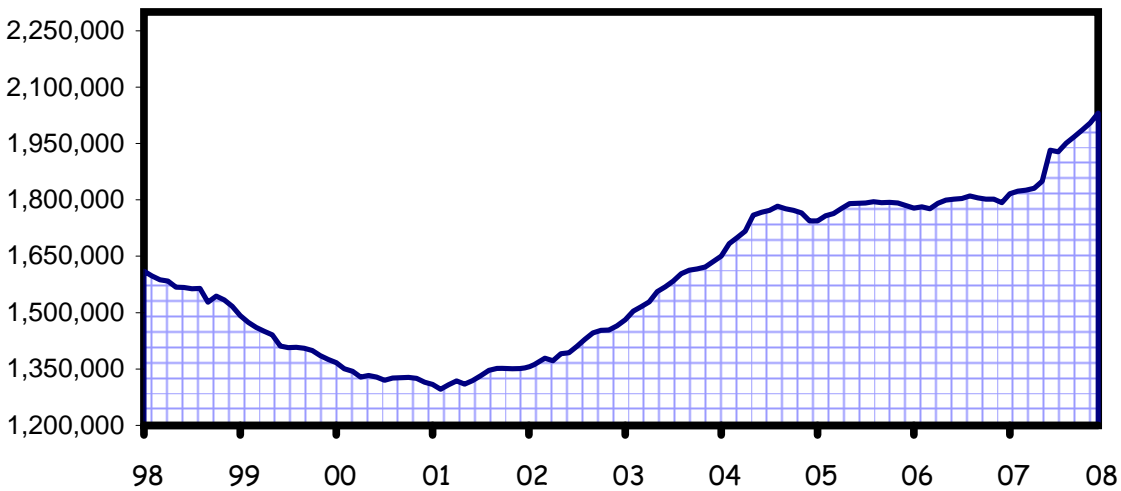

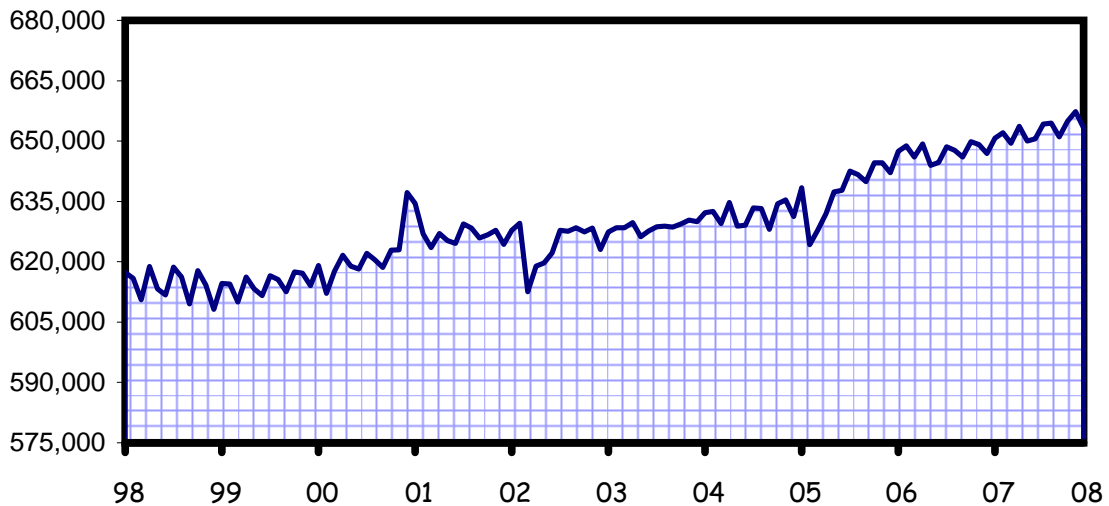
