Temporary Assistance

Temporary Assistance: Temporary Assistance recipients totaled 509,923 in October 2008, increasing by 8,874 (+1.8%) from the previous month. Related expenditures totaled \$159,945,023 in October 2008, increasing by approximately \$2.9 million (+1.9%) over September 2008.

Food Stamps

Food Stamps: Recipients of Food Stamps numbered 2,114,221 in October 2008, increasing by 36,447 (+1.8%) over September 2008. Food Stamps expenditures totaled \$283,912,735 in October 2008, increasing by approximately \$56.4 million (+24.8%) over the previous month.

The large expenditure increase was the result of both enrollment increases and the changes to benefit calculations implemented for the start of the Federal Fiscal Year.

Supplemental Security Income

Supplemental Security Income: For October 2008, SSI recipients (including Mental Hygiene) totaled 656,801 decreasing by 4,365 (-0.7%) from the previous month. SSI expenditures in October 2008, totaled \$349,309,358 decreasing by approximately \$7.2 million (-2.0%) from September 2008.

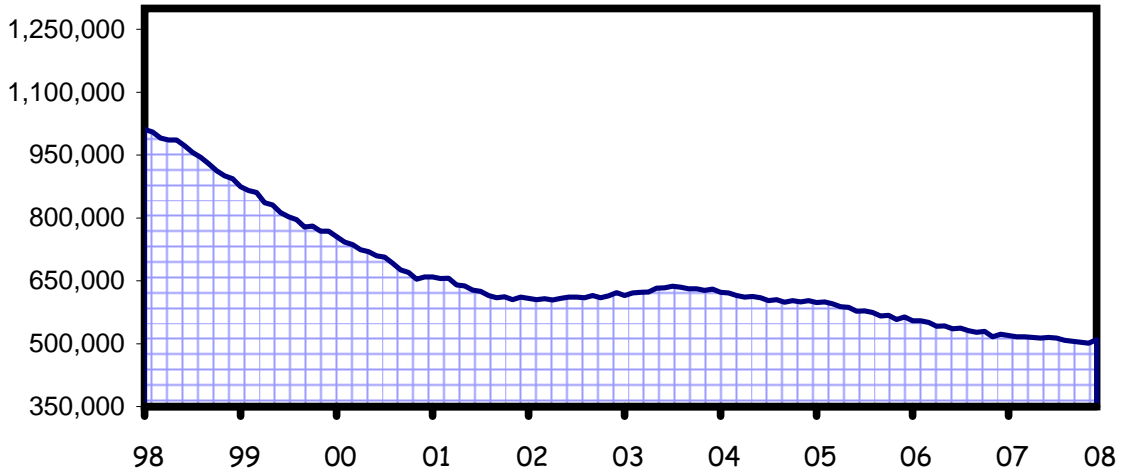
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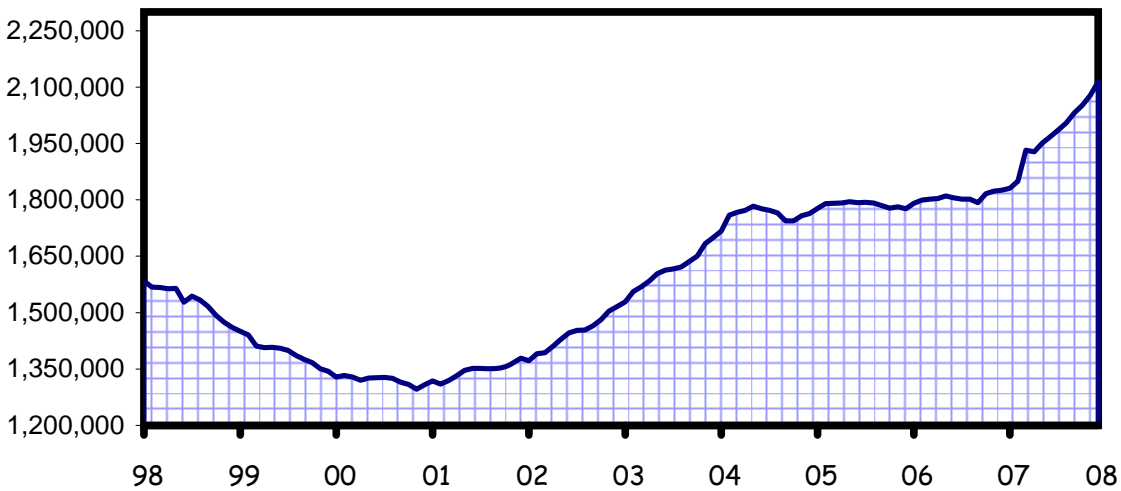
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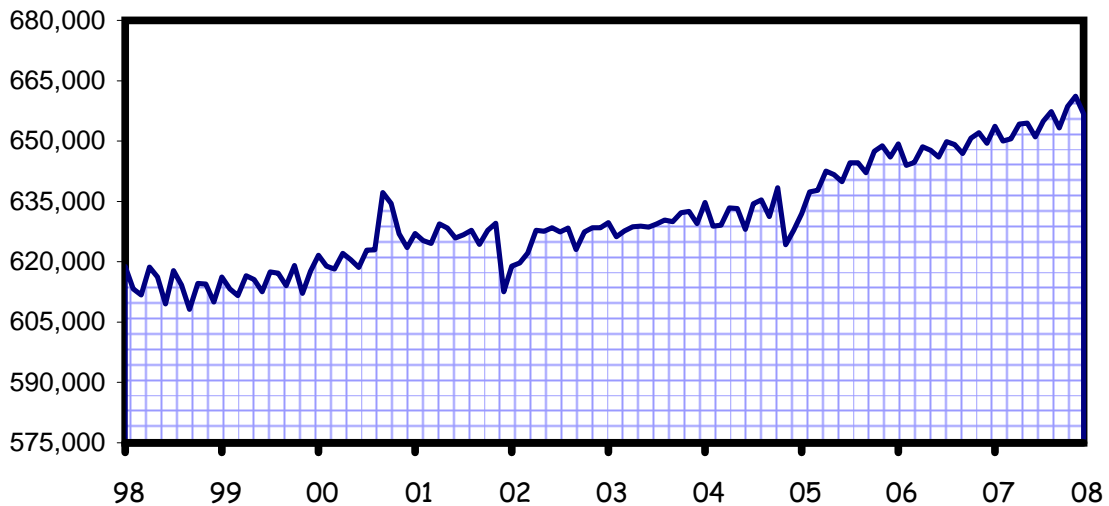
**NEW YORK STATE
