Temporary Assistance

Temporary Assistance: Temporary Assistance recipients totaled 545,063 in February 2010, decreasing by 1,285 (-0.2%) from the previous month. Related expenditures totaled \$167,867,989 in February 2010, decreasing by \$765,442 (-0.5%) over January 2010.

Food Stamps

Food Stamps: Recipients of Food Stamps numbered 2,712,437 in February 2010, increasing by 12,851 (+0.5%) over January 2010. Food Stamps expenditures totaled \$412,650,683 in February 2010, decreasing by \$736,020 (-0.2%) over the previous month.

Supplemental Security Income

Supplemental Security Income: For February 2010, SSI recipients (including Mental Hygiene) totaled 675,811 increasing by 7,028 (+1.1%) from the previous month. SSI expenditures in February 2010 totaled \$386,130,533 increasing by approximately \$12.6 million (+3.4%) from January 2010.

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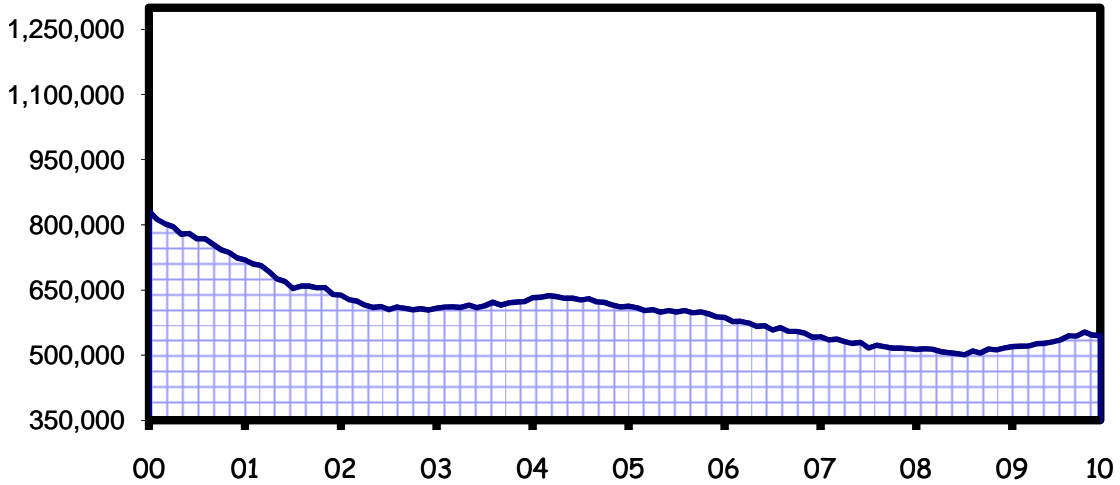
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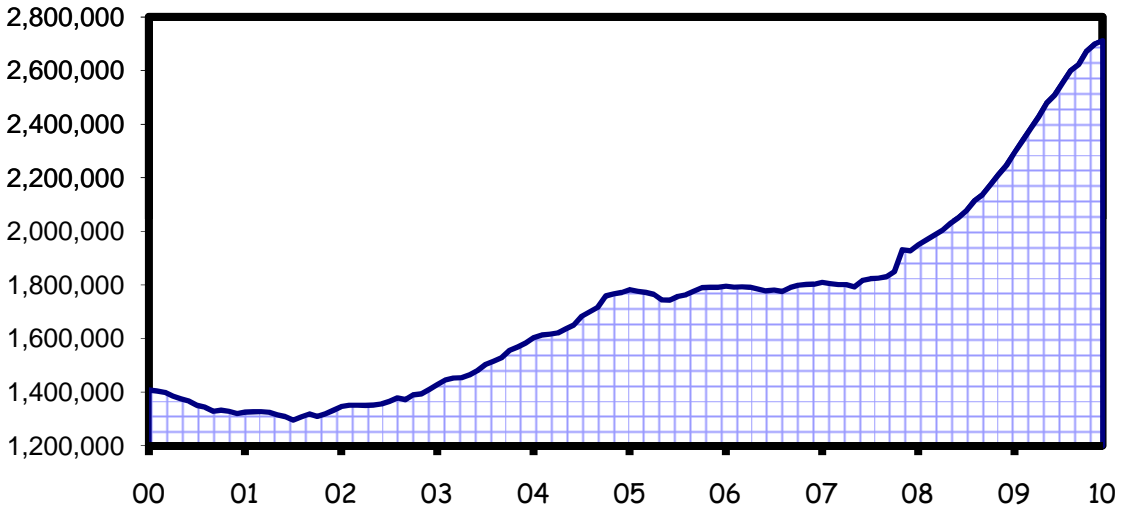
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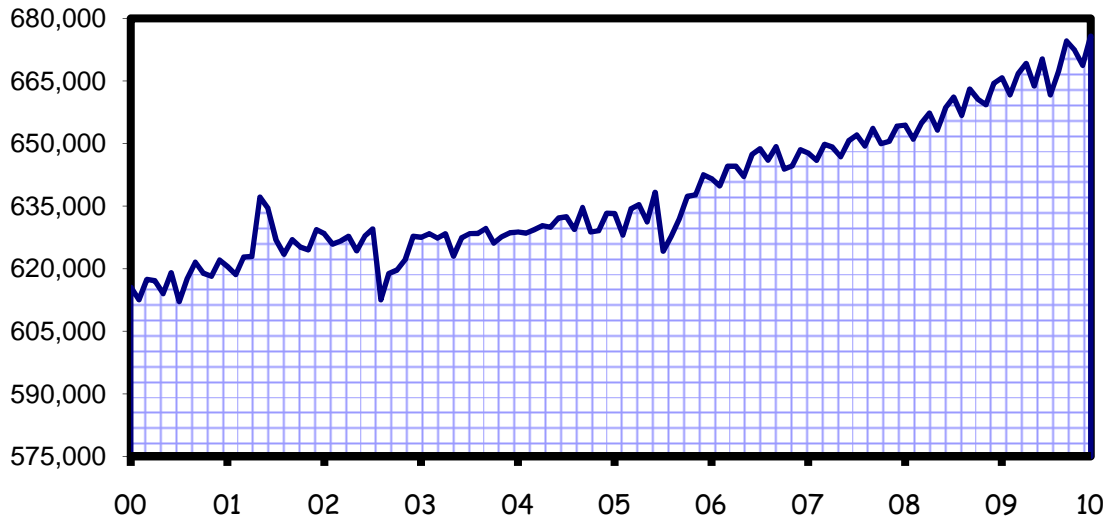
