Temporary and Disability Assistance Statistics **APRIL 2011**

Temporary Assistance

Temporary Assistance: Temporary Assistance recipients totaled 568,507 in April 2011, increasing by 2,129 (+0.4%) from the previous month. Related expenditures totaled \$175,979,708 in April 2011, decreasing by approximately \$10.8 million (-5.8%) over March 2011.

Food Stamps

Food Stamps: Food Stamp recipients totaled 3,017,404 in April 2011, increasing by 3,459 (+0.1%) from the previous month. Food Stamp expenditures totaled \$448,910,126 in April 2011, decreasing by approximately \$8.2 million (-1.8%) over March 2011.

Supplemental Security Income

Supplemental Security Income: For April 2011, SSI recipients (including Mental Hygiene) totaled 684,638, increasing by 6,244 (+0.9%) from the previous month. SSI expenditures in April 2011 totaled \$384,536,743, increasing by approximately \$4.3 million (+1.1%) over March 2011.

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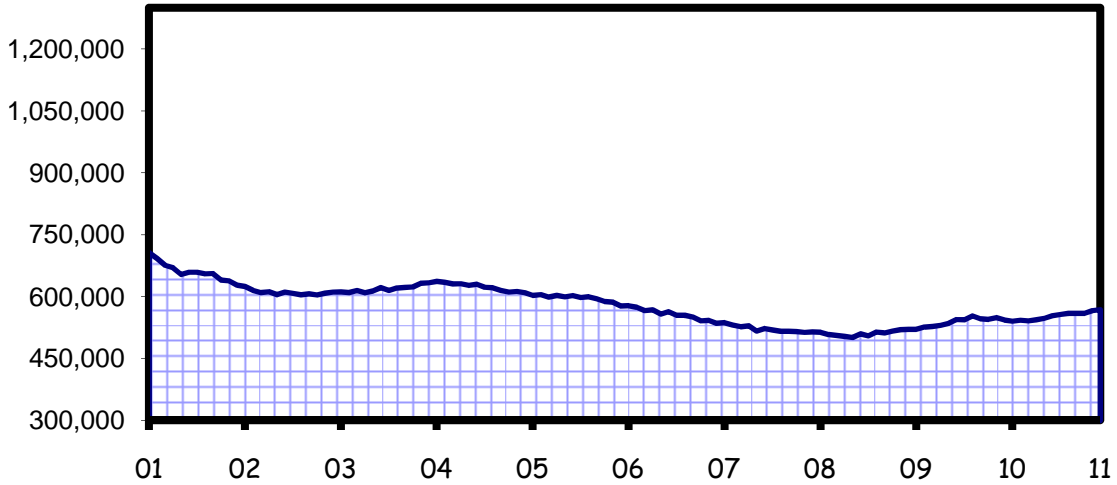
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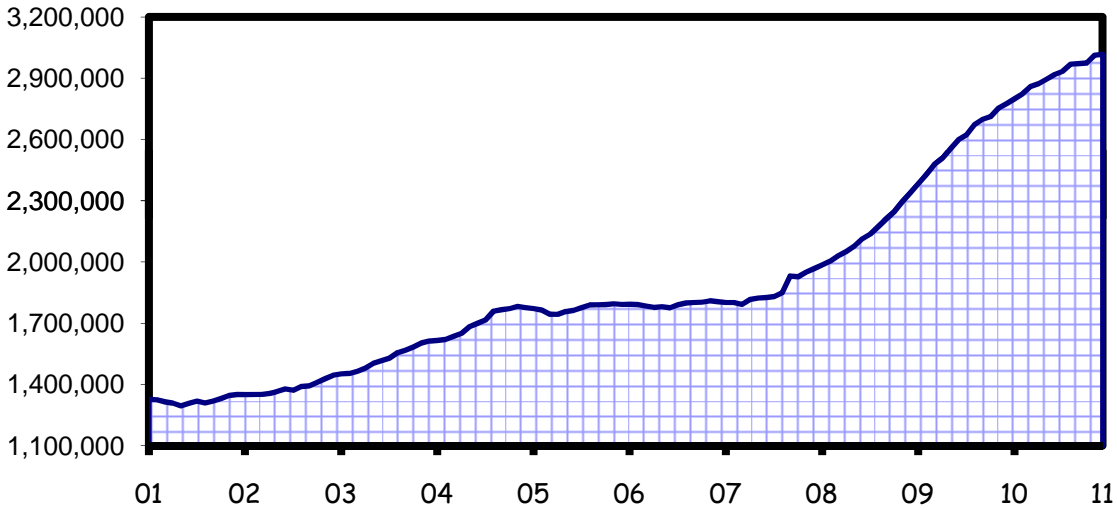
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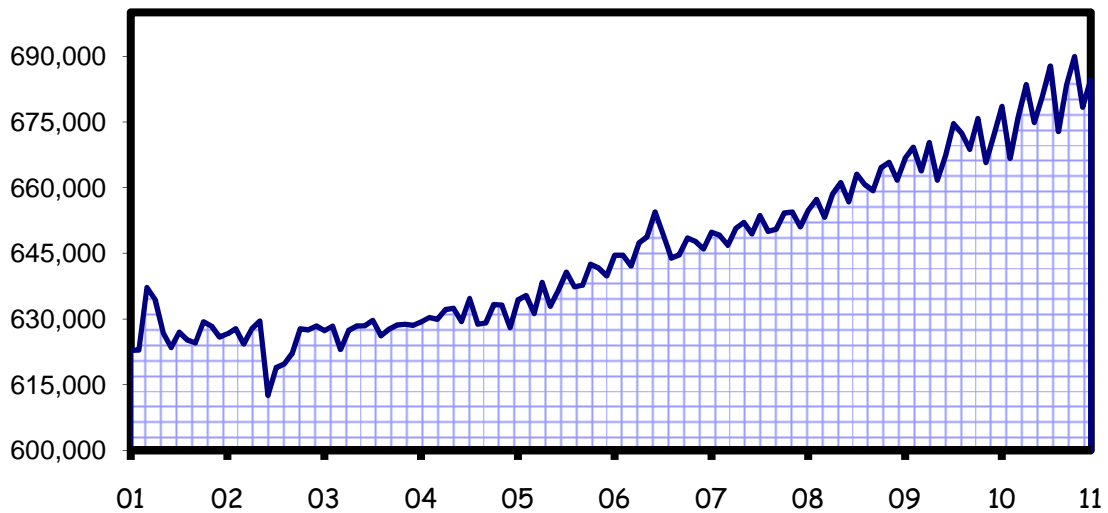
