Temporary and Disability Assistance Statistics **AUGUST 2011**

Temporary Assistance

Temporary Assistance: Temporary Assistance recipients totaled 566,897 in August 2011, increasing by 5,821 (+1.0%) from the previous month. Related expenditures totaled \$176,094,628 in August 2011, increasing by approximately \$3.1 million (+1.8%) over July 2011.

Food Stamps

Food Stamps: Food Stamp recipients totaled 3,040,684 in August 2011, decreasing by 3,067 (-0.1%) from the previous month. Food Stamp expenditures totaled \$452,675,705 in August 2011, increasing by approximately \$1.2 million (+0.3%) over July 2011.

Supplemental Security Income

Supplemental Security Income: For August 2011, SSI recipients (including Mental Hygiene) totaled 694,162, increasing by 1,758 (+0.3%) from the previous month. SSI expenditures in August 2011 totaled \$393,277,552 increasing by approximately \$4.7 million (+1.2%) over July 2011.

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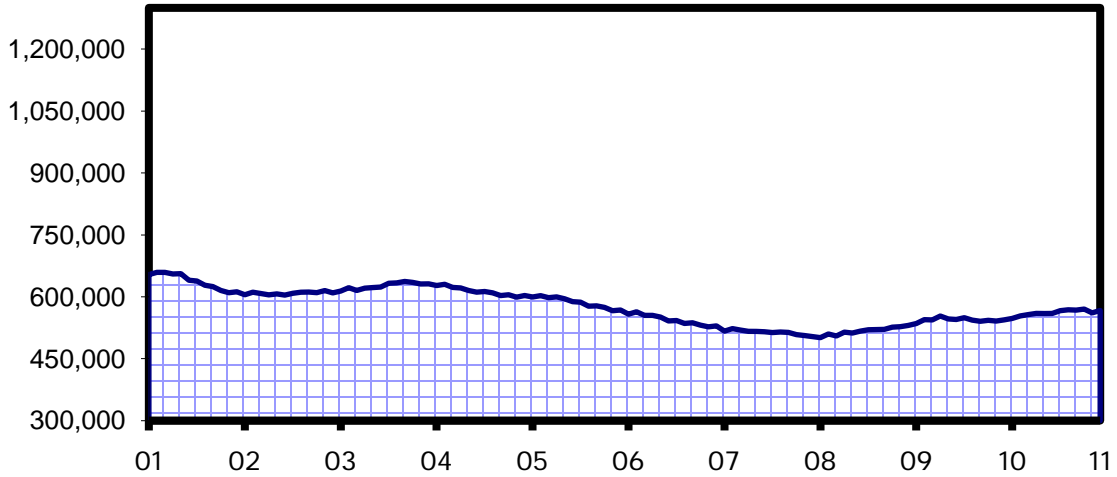
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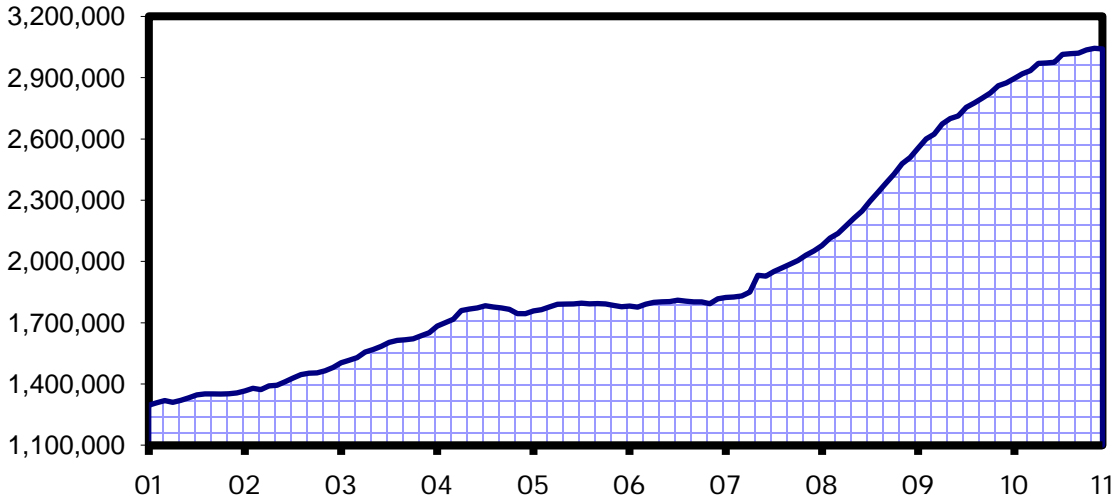
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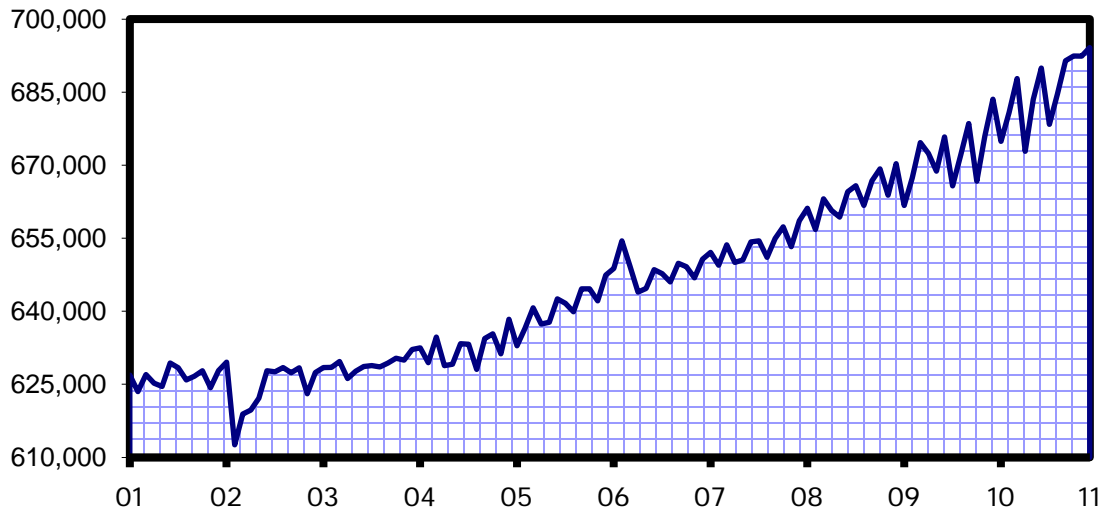
