Temporary and Disability Assistance Statistics **AUGUST 2012**

Temporary Assistance

Temporary Assistance: Temporary Assistance recipients totaled 568,838 in August 2012, increasing by 4,411 (+0.8%) from the previous month. Related expenditures totaled \$181,788,222 in August 2012, increasing by approximately \$3.4 million (+3.4%) over July 2012.

Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program

Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program: Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program recipients totaled 3,109,436 in August 2012, increasing by 14,759 (+0.5%) from the previous month. Related expenditures totaled \$462,400,126 in August 2012, increasing by approximately \$5.4 million (+1.2%) over July 2012.

Supplemental Security Income

Supplemental Security Income: Supplemental Security Income recipients (including Mental Hygiene) totaled 699,809 in August 2012, increasing by 4,255 (+0.6%) from the previous month. Related expenditures totaled \$403,409,078 in August 2012, increasing by approximately \$1.9 million (+0.5%) over July 2012.

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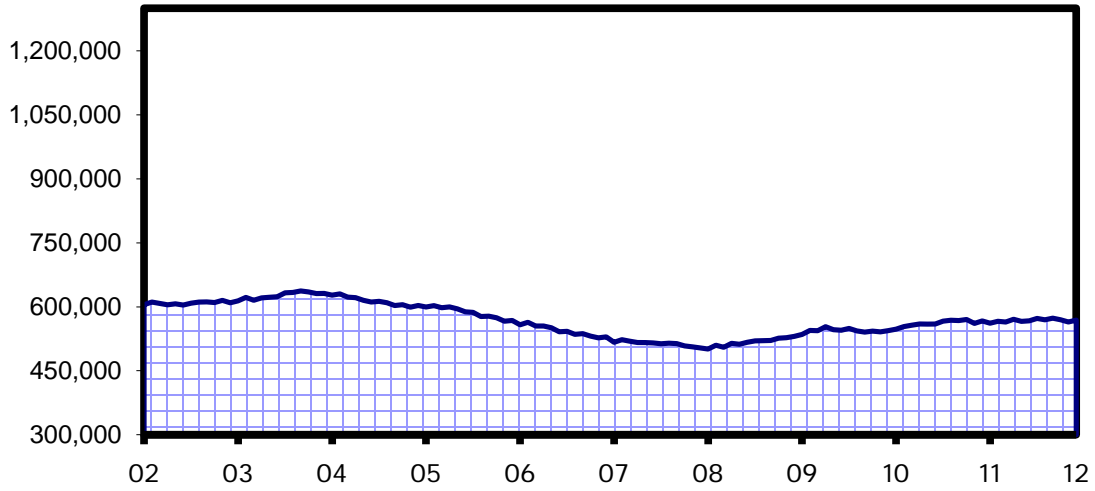
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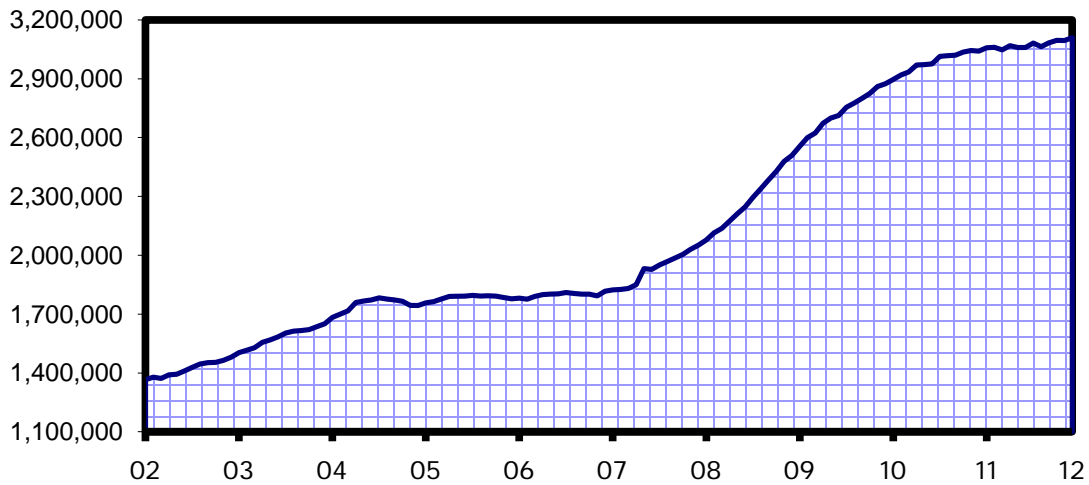
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NEW YORK STATE September 2002 - August 2012 TEN YEAR TREND

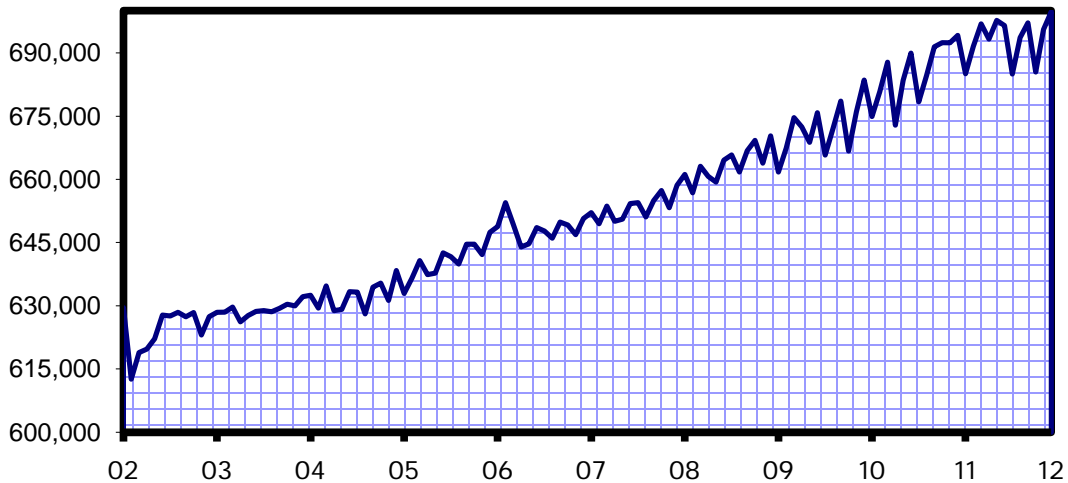
Temporary Assistance Recipients
