Temporary Assistance

Temporary Assistance: Temporary Assistance recipients totaled 573,292 in October 2013, increasing by 4,118 (+0.7%) from the previous month. Related expenditures totaled \$187,274,153 in October 2013, increasing by approximately \$7.6 million (+4.2%) over September 2013.

Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program

Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program: Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program recipients totaled 3,170,323 in October 2013, increasing by 960 (+0.03%) from the previous month. Related expenditures totaled \$468,322,218 in October 2013, increasing by approximately \$6.0 million (+1.3%) over September 2013.

Supplemental Security Income

Supplemental Security Income: Supplemental Security Income recipients (including Mental Hygiene) totaled 700,729 in October 2013, increasing by 8,157 (+1.2%) from the previous month. Related expenditures totaled \$406,538,400 in October 2013, increasing by approximately \$4.0 million (+1.0%) over September 2013.

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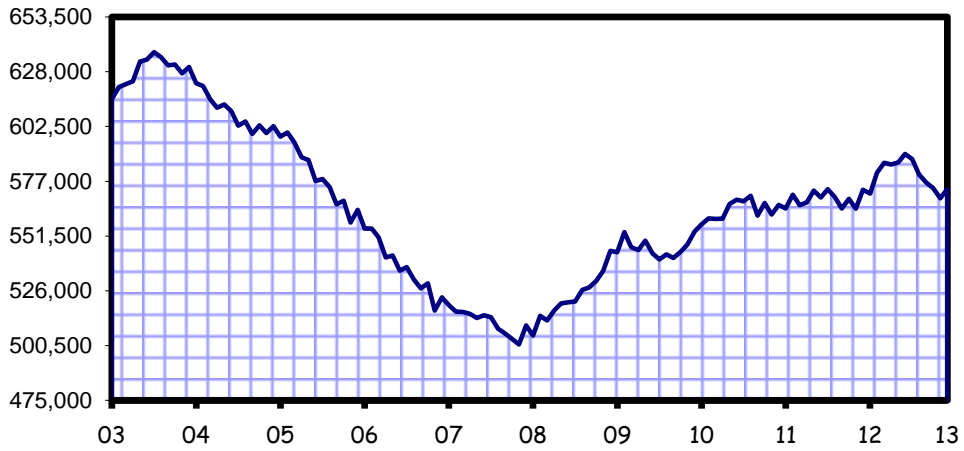
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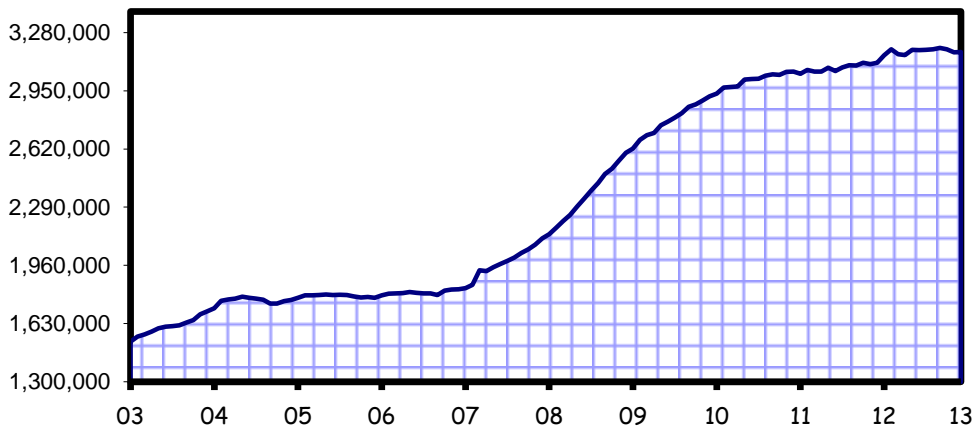

TEN YEAR TREND**

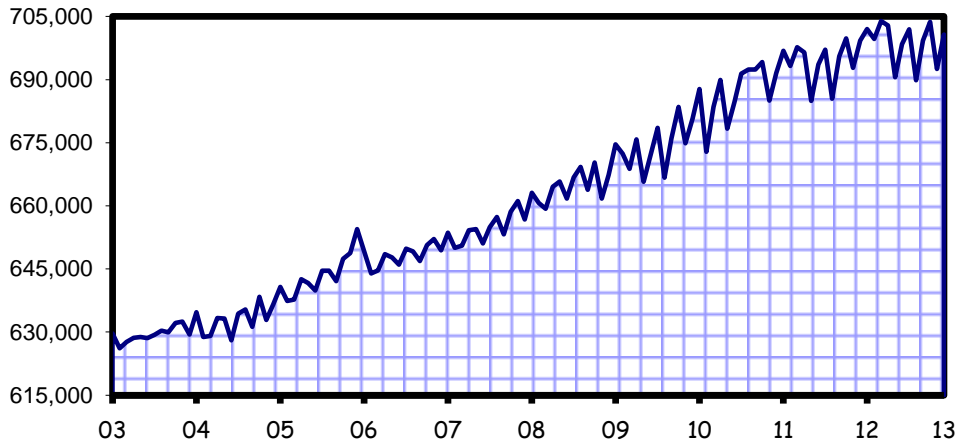
Temporary Assistance Recipients
