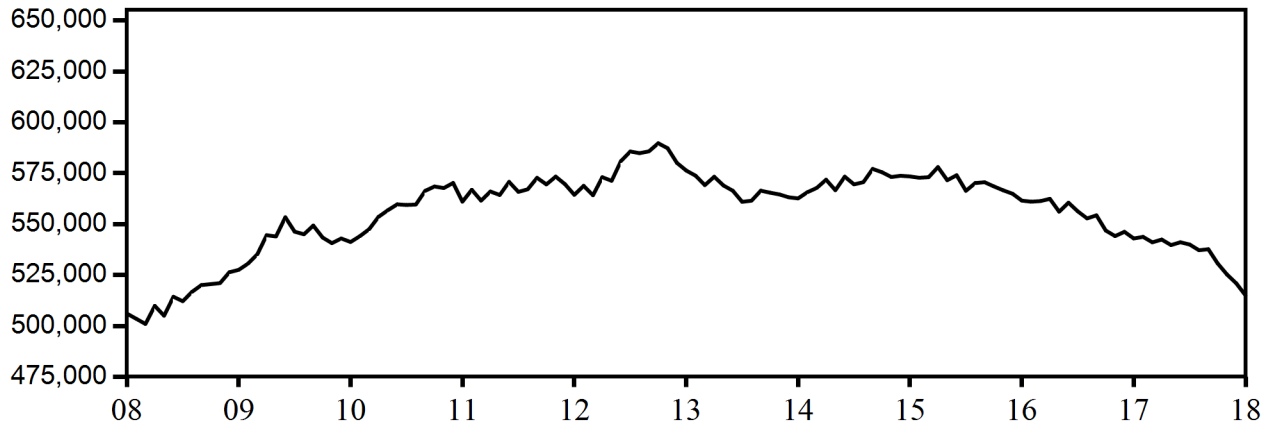

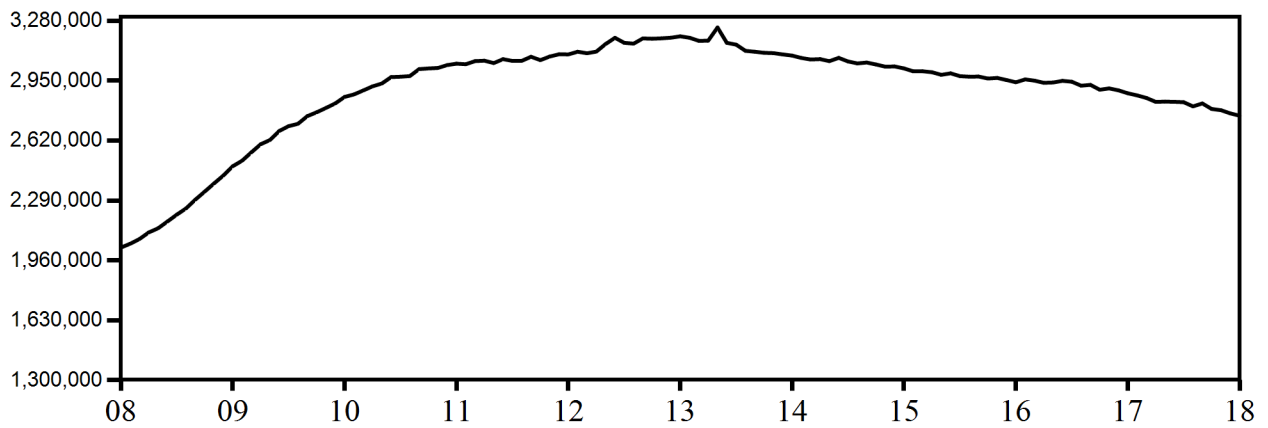

TEN YEAR TREND

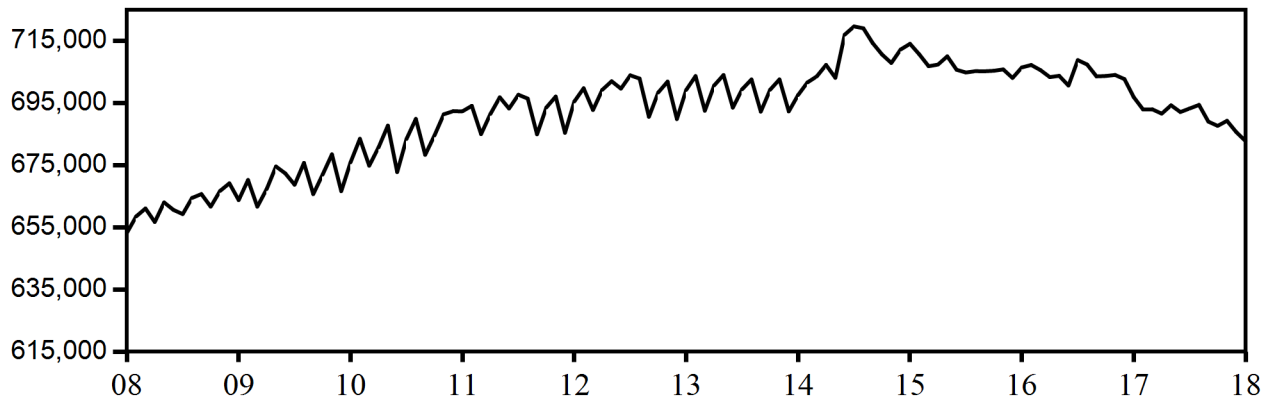
